- Is contrary to the Student Edge core values and governing philosophies
- Distributes advertorial or marketing materials (For your business's advertising and marketing needs, Student Edge has a number of products, please refer to our [media kit](#) or contact one of our [Business Development staff](#).)
- Uses inappropriate language or is not appropriate for students
- Disrespects or is insensitive to the diversity of cultures, races, beliefs and identities present in Australia's student community
- Promotes any illegal, immoral or unhealthy behaviour, such as drug or alcohol abuse
- Condone or is likely to provoke violence or anti-social behaviour
- Contains information that is false or misleading
- Endorses a particular political party or agenda or is closely tied to federal and state political parties
- Centres on a topic beyond a business's or organisation's area of expertise
- Violates any of [Student Edge's terms and conditions](#) and/or Australian federal or state law.
