

'Win a \$500 Bankwest Student Account' - TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following Terms and Conditions apply for Student Edge's 'Win a \$500 Bankwest Student Account' contest. By participating in the competition, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. These Terms and Conditions apply in conjunction with Student Edge's General Contest Rules. 1. METHOD OF ENTRY
